Guidelines

- Anyone who brings his/her privately owned computer to Skagway School District is personally responsible for the equipment.
- Responsibility for the maintenance and repair of the equipment rests solely with that individual.
- Any damage to the equipment, including results from viruses, is the responsibility of the individual.
- Software residing on privately owned computers must be personally owned. The school district is not responsible for providing software applications.
- The district retains the right to determine where and when privately owned equipment may be attached to the school network (as long as he/she has an signed Internet User Agreement on file.)

Music, Games and Screensavers

- During school hours music and videos are allowed for academic purposes only.
- Pornographic, obscene or vulgar images as well as inappropriate sounds, music and foul language may not played or viewed on school property. This includes screen savers, backgrounds and pictures.

Cyberbullying

- The District's computer network and the Internet may not be used for the purpose of cyber bullying. All forms of cyber bullying are unacceptable and viewed as a violation of this policy.

District Rights

- Monitor all activity.
- Make determinations on whether specific uses of the computer are consistent with the district's Policy and Procedure.
- Remove the user's access to the network and suspend the right to use the privately owned computer in district facilities at any time it is determined that the user is engaged in unauthorized activity or is violating District Policy and Procedure.
- **Disciplinary Action**
- Violations may be cause for removing the individual's Internet access privileges, suspension of use of privately owned computer in school, and other disciplinary actions
